

EvoLibri provides multidisciplinary services to neurodivergent teens and adults, their families and their employers, throughout their lives.

Who We Are



EvoLibri is a multidisciplinary agency in Silicon Valley serving low-needs, neurodivergent people ages 14 through adulthood.

We partner with the **Department of Rehabilitation** to provide as many of our services as possible to all individuals and families, regardless of income.

We are also a **Non-Public Agency**, working with students in the Bay Area and beyond, and also hold contracts with organizations providing coaching for neurodivergent, professional employees in the tech sector.

Our mission is to ensure that all neurodivergent people reach their potential by removing barriers in their lives.

The Basics

This program is for graduating neurodivergent seniors (autism, ADHD, LD, mood disorders) who plan on going to college, but who may need support than most college-bound students do not. Ideal candidates have been mostly or partially mainstreamed in high school and can function on a campus independently.

What Is Provided

This program is two years in length, and provides the following support, provided by EvoLibri staff:

Pre-College Support

Career counseling and Field of Study selection

Independent Living Skills instruction

Help with registering for accommodations

College Support

Quarterly help with registering for classes

Weekly 1:1 academic success (EF) and self-advocacy coaching

Weekly cohort/group meetings

Social activities

Additional Support

Help with selecting transfer colleges, and help applying

(If needed) Referral for specialized academic/subject matter tutoring

Low-income families can also apply to the DOR for reimbursements for tuition and materials/books

Why This Program

Many neurodivergent kids – who should go to college – are not quite ready and need some guidance along the way. In fact, the US Department of Education states that **only 38% of students with a disability complete their post-secondary programming.*** We can change that by providing ongoing support through the first two years of college.

How To Apply

Our application period will run from April 1, 2023 until May 15, 2023. We prefer all applications to be sent to us via email at dor@evolibri.com. We will contact all applicants in late May. Students must be available for our onboarding and LifeLaunch ILS programming which runs Mid-June through Early July and be able to travel to Santa Clara for those three weeks only.
